In addition to the above minimum prequalification for prime contractors, this project includes a sub-classification of Cb or Ea. If the prime contractor is not prequalified in all of the above classifications, prequalified subcontractors must be used. Subcontractors must be prequalified in their respective work area and designated prior to award of the contract to the confirmed low bidder.
