

CPL LICENSE FAQs

Welcome to the Oscoda County Concealed Pistol License (CPL) "Frequently Asked Questions" page.

How much does it cost to get a CPL?

The Concealed Pistol License Filing Fee is \$115 for New Applicants (which includes fingerprinting fee), and \$115 for Renewal Applicants. Methods of payment accepted: cash , check or money order. Make Checks or Money payable to Oscoda County Clerk.

Where can I obtain a Concealed Pistol License Application kit?

The Concealed Pistol License application kit is available at the Oscoda County Clerk's Office.

Where do I get fingerprinted?

Fingerprinting is done at the time of processing a New CPL Application from the County Clerk's Office. The County Clerk's Office will contact the Oscoda County Sheriff's Department to schedule for fingerprinting. This must be completed within 45 days from the day you submit your New Application at the County Clerk's Office.

Who is required to take training?

Training is required for all new applicants and any renewal applicants that had a CPL prior to July 1, 2001, and any applicants renewing for the first time after July 1, 2001.

Who is excluded from training?

The training is waived for an applicant who is a retired peace officer. Proof of retirement is required at the time of application, the training requirement for an active duty law enforcement officer is to present a letter on department stationary indicating you have met the necessary training requirements and/or qualifications and are in good standing with the department.

Where do I go for training?

Call the National Rifle Association (NRA) or an affiliated club at 1-800-672-3888 and ask to be directed to the Education & Training Department. Or check with the Oscoda County Clerk's Office to check local availability.

What is the Status of my CPL application?

If you are a New CPL applicant you should receive your license within 45 days of the application date. If you are a Renewal CPL applicant you should receive your license within 30 days of the application date. If you have not received your license after that time, you may call the Oscoda County Clerk's Office at 989-826-1110 to check on your status.

What happens if I lose/misplace my CPL?

If your CPL is stolen, report that to your local Sheriff Department. You may obtain a replacement from the County Clerk's Office for \$10. Bring your government-issued picture ID (driver's license, etc) and the fee along with a copy of the police report to the Clerk's Office and a new license will be issued.

What happens if I move/change addresses WITHIN Oscoda County?

The permit is valid until it expires, but you are required to have your current address updated within the county in which your CPL was issued.

What happens if I move OUT of Oscoda County (still within the State of Michigan) after I receive my CPL?

The license is still valid until it expires. After expiration, you would apply in the county in which you reside.

How do I change my address on my CPL?

Simply bring your newly issued Driver's License to the County Clerk's Office, showing the correct address. We will make necessary changes in our database & inform the MI State Police of the change.
