June 19, 2017  
Minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**The well work** is done and a new spigot is installed in front of the cook shack, making water available to those at the pavilion.

**Chemical Bank:** No decision made yet on whether to switch banks.

**A new fire truck** has been purchased and should arrive next month.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Golf carts:** Sheriff Kevin Grace and the board discussed the question of policy regarding golf carts on the roads and variations in the requirements. The sheriff dept. is okay with them on the road as long as they are driving safely. Kevin emphasized that local policies cannot supersede state law. The Sheriff also mentioned other things happening in the county including the speed limit increases and possible confusion and accidents (with deer and winter roads) it may cause; and that July 4<sup>th</sup> fireworks have been moved back to Mio this year.

Marty reported that the Road Commission is interested in trying crushed limestone on a road to see if it's a good alternative to asphalt. His suggestion will be to try Gerber Rd between Kittle and Kneeland.

**Rental policy:** Jenni would like the hall rental forms to discourage use of tacks or tape on walls and woodwork.
