

Military Discharge Records

About Military Discharge Records (DD-214)

For a military veteran residing in Oscoda County, it is recommended that you record your military discharge (DD-214) for safekeeping with the Oscoda County Clerk's Office. This is an important document that is usually needed for veterans' benefits.

File Your DD-214

Bring in your original discharge (which will be immediately returned to you) and a copy will be kept in our Office.

Replace a Lost DD-214

Request Certified Copies

Military discharges are confidential. They are **not** public records and are not allowed to be viewed by the public. The individual (with ID) or family member with a death certificate may obtain copies.
