GREENWOOD TOWNSHIP Proposal for Brine Millage

This proposal will permit the Township to levy up to ½ mill for the purpose of providing funds for gravel road dust control brine.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Greenwood, Oscoda County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to (1/2) mill (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for gravel road dust control brine, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$51,539 for the Township in 2024.

C.O.O.R. INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT AREA CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROPOSAL

Sall C.O.O.R. Intermediate School District, Michigan, come under sections 681 to 690 of the Revised School Code, as amended, and establish an area career and technical education program, which is designed to encourage the operation of area career and technical education programs, if the annual property tax levied for this purpose is limited to 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2024 to 2033, inclusive; the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2024 is approximately \$3,907,442 from local property taxes authorized herein?
