Pullum stated people come to this county for the trail system, hunting and fishing. Pullum it is hard to get a bear permit in this county. Pullum stated the bait ban has not really affected the hunters in this area. Pullum stated about 80% of the blinds they check have bait. Pullum stated they had a few cases of TB in this county. Pullum stated USDA is managing the deer population in the county. Pullum stated hunters are declining. Pullum advised Ausable River is trophy waters. Pullum stated anglers are very compliant in this county. Pullum advised issues on the river are declining.
