For 2023, MERS will bill the County using the No Phase-in option UNLESS we contact them otherwise.

- 1) Mr. William Kendall, Treasurer Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund for Eligible Revenue Sharing Counties
  - This is part of the America Rescue Plan.
  - Most counties within Michigan qualified for these funds.
  - Oscoda County qualified for a total of \$826,000, receiving \$413,000 in 2022 and will receive an additional \$413,000 in 2023.
  - The Treasurer is required to report in March 2023.
  - Funds can't be used for Lobbying.
  - ARPA Funds are currently invested in a Money Market account and we will be gaining additional interest. Commissioner Varner stated that these funds will come in useful for the Sheriff Department rebuild.
