NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

FUNDING FOR THE 2025 URGENT NEED PROGRAM**

Oscoda County will conduct a public hearing on February 24, 2026 at 10am during the Board of Commissioners Meeting at 105 S Court Street, Mio, MI 48647 for the purpose of affording citizens an opportunity to examine and submit comments on the 2025 Urgent Need Program Application.

Oscoda County proposes to use \$72,000.00 in CDBG funds to purchase generators and receive minor financial assistance towards generator operational needs. The County will distribute generators to businesses providing health and safety benefits to the community, operating in a brick-and-mortar structure within Oscoda County. No more than 30 generators will be distributed through the 2025 Urgent Need Program.
